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Marrakech - Ait Benhaddou - Essaouira - Marrakech

Day 1: arrival 13 April 2026, Marrakech

Welcome to Morocco! Arrive into Marrakech airport where you'll be met by our local driver, for the short transfer to our accommodation in La Ville Nouvelle. This evening, we'll meet our fellow sketchers and have a tour briefing with Tricia before our welcome dinner. If you're arriving into Casablanca, we can assist with a transfer to Marrakech (three hours' drive), at additional cost. (D)

Our drive this morning brings us to Ouarzazate, where we'll stop to see some traditional brass and copper work and silver jewellery and have lunch. Then on to Ait Benhaddou, an 11th century ksar (fortified village), UNESCO World Heritage Site and filming location for many famous movies, including Gladiator and Games of Thrones. We'll spend the afternoon exploring the kasbah, with its cute shops, art studios and cafes and a viewpoint at the top, overlooking the valley and mountains beyond. (B)

Day 3: 15 April 2026, Ait Benhaddou

A full day in Ait Benhaddou, sketching in the kasbah, exploring and shopping. There are several resident artists inside the kasbah - we will stop to watch them at work. We can share our stories of the day over dinner tonight in this truly exotic part of the world. (B)

Day 4: 16 April 2026, Marrakech

After breakfast this morning, we have a scenic drive over the High Atlas Mountains to the 'red city' of Marrakech. The vibrancy of Marrakech cannot be found anywhere else in the world! We will explore, sketch and soak in the atmosphere. This evening, we'll wander through the main square, Jemaa el Fnaa, with snake charmers, entertainers and musicians - it truly comes alive after dusk (B).

We'll spend time sketching the fountains, exotic plants and striking buildings of this beautiful garden.







Day 6: 18 April 2026, Marrakech

The Bahia Palace is our destination this morning, a beautiful 19th century palace on the edge of the medina. There is free time this afternoon for a traditional Moroccan spa (hamman), or to relax at the riad, go shopping or admire the incredible colours of the Marrakech medina. Dinner tonight will be a feast for our senses, in the famous Al Fassia, an all-female managed restaurant (own expense). (B)



Day 7: 19 April 2026, Essaouira

This morning, we drive to the laid-back coastal city of Essaouira, overlooking the Atlantic Ocean, stopping en route at an argan oil co-operative. Famous for its seafood, handicrafts and thriving arts scene, it's the perfect place to unwind. This afternoon, we will sketch and explore and, if riding a camel along a beach at sunset is your dream, then this is the evening we can do it. Dinner tonight will be in a local restaurant inside the medina. (B)
